The college was accredited with grade "B" by NAAC Peer Team. However, this was achieved at a great cost of money. I was resolved that the college fund which was depleted, would be built up.

1. Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the college: The College resolved to build up the College fund and prepare for RUSA funding.
2. New academic programmes initiated (UG and PG): a general/pass course in Education was started.
3. Innovations in curricular design and transaction: Since the University decides the curriculum the college has no say in the matter. The college was affiliated to Bankura University since 2017 and the semester system as per university rules was introduced.

5. Examination reforms implemented: open book tests and projects were initiated. However, the university decides the format of examinations leaving little or no scope for colleges to innovate in this regard.

21. Improvements in the library services: the library gained a trained librarian. The new librarian has applied himself and his staff to the task of properly organizing and modernizing the library.
22. New books/journals subscribed and their value: 38 copies of books have been added the value of which is approximately Rs.8000/
23. Courses in which student assessment of teachers is introduced and the action taken on student feedback: currently such course cannot be taken up because of the transition to the semester system as well as the challenges of adjusting to the change in university.
24. Feedback from stakeholders: due to changeover to the semester system and the transition from Burdwan to Bankura University the college could not organize feedback system.

Computerization of administration and the process of admissions and examination results, issue of certificates: the process of admissions was computerized already as per requirements of the University of Burdwan to which the college was affiliated at that time. Examination results and issue of certificates have been computerized too. Bankura University has fully computerized all official processes.
27. Increase in the infrastructural facilities: auditorium has already been built for NAAC Peer Team Visit but there are plans to build a new one with RUSA funds.
28. Technology up gradation: computerization is fully achieved in official matters.
29. Computer and internet access and training to teachers, non-teaching staff and students: students already availed of the training facilities provided by WEBEL computer centre located within the college premises. Teachers and

- non-teaching staff were encouraged to visit the WEBEL computer centre to improve their knowledge as and when they could.
30. Financial aid to students: Half-free-ship to poor but meritorious students is available as per official policies. Kanyashree facilities were also implemented for girl students.
  31. Activities and support from the Alumni Association: the Alumni Association was functioning on an ad hoc and informal basis so no organized support was available.
  32. Activities and support from the Parent-Teacher Association: the Parent-Teacher Association was functioning on an ad hoc and informal basis so no organized support was available.
  33. Health services: the college started to maintain a first-aid kit at the NSS office and refers cases to the village health centre.
  34. Performance in sports activities: college students, both boys and girls, participated at university-level football tournaments and volleyball tournaments with success
  35. Incentives to outstanding sportspersons: College awards certificates and felicitates outstanding sportspersons among college students.
  36. Student achievements and awards: NCC & NSS students regularly win awards and have participated in the Republic Day Parade at New Delhi.
